Directions:

From the Pennsylvania Turnpike: Take the Willow Grove Turnpike exit No. 27 and immediately bear right to Route 611 North. Go 1.3 miles on Route 611. Move to the left lane. Shortly after passing the Horsham Days Inn on your left will be the intersection for 611 and Horsham Road (Route 463). At this light turn left onto Horsham Road and continue for 2.2 miles. Turn left onto Hatboro-Horsham High School grounds. The theater entrance is through the main entrance of the building.

From the Intersections of Routes 202, 309 and 463. Go East on Route 463 (Horsham Road) for 5.5 miles and turn right onto school grounds.
